



Let all the earth cry out to God with joy.




Shout joy - fully to God all the earth: Sing praise to the glo - ry of his name.




Proclaim his glorious praise: Say to God how tre-men-dous are your deeds.




Let all on earth worship and sing praise to you: Sing praise to your name.
